

Strong Foundations


- Small business lending per worker is 2nd highest in the nation





 - Increase R&D funding; strengthen technology transfer and access to capital



- Develop, implement and monitor coordinated internal and external marketing plan


Enhance competitiveness of legal environment

 Promote recent enhancements to Mississippi's liability system; ensure legislative reforms are properly implemented and maintained




Key Targets

Perception of Liability System Rank among 50 States





 Underscore linkage between education and employment, targeting middle school students


Goals and Recommendations
