


PLANNING ON GOING TO COLLEGE? CHOOSE MISSISSIPPI SCHOLARS.

Mississippi Scholars is a college-prep program designed with STEM-based education in mind, engaging students in science, technology, engineering and math.







MISSISSIPPI SCHOLARS CURRICULUM AND REQUIREMENTS

- 80 hours for seniors graduating 2022 and later
- 19 for seniors graduating 2022 and later
- 25 high school GP on a 4.0 scale
- Three letters of recommendation (one from each of the following – principal, guidance counselor and business/community leader for students with more than 4 inschool suspensions
- 95% school attendance during high school years
- No out-of-school suspension

READY TO JOIN THE WORKFORCE? BECOME A TECH MASTER.

Mississippi Scholars Tech Master is a program where students undergo a more hands-on approach to their high school experience. With a curriculum similar to and just as rigorous as Mississippi Scholars, Tech Master prepares students who wish to begin a career right after graduation by applying the workforce readiness they developed in high school.







TECH MASTER CURRICULUM AND REQUIREMENTS

- 80 hours for seniors graduating 2022 and later
- 19 for seniors graduating 2022 and later or minimum 36 ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Test)
- Silver Level WorkKeys required
- 25 high school GP on a 4.0 scale
- 95% school attendance during high school years
- No out-of-school suspension
- Must have a passing score, as established by the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) on an MDE-approved industry certification assessment.








MORE THAN ONE PATH




