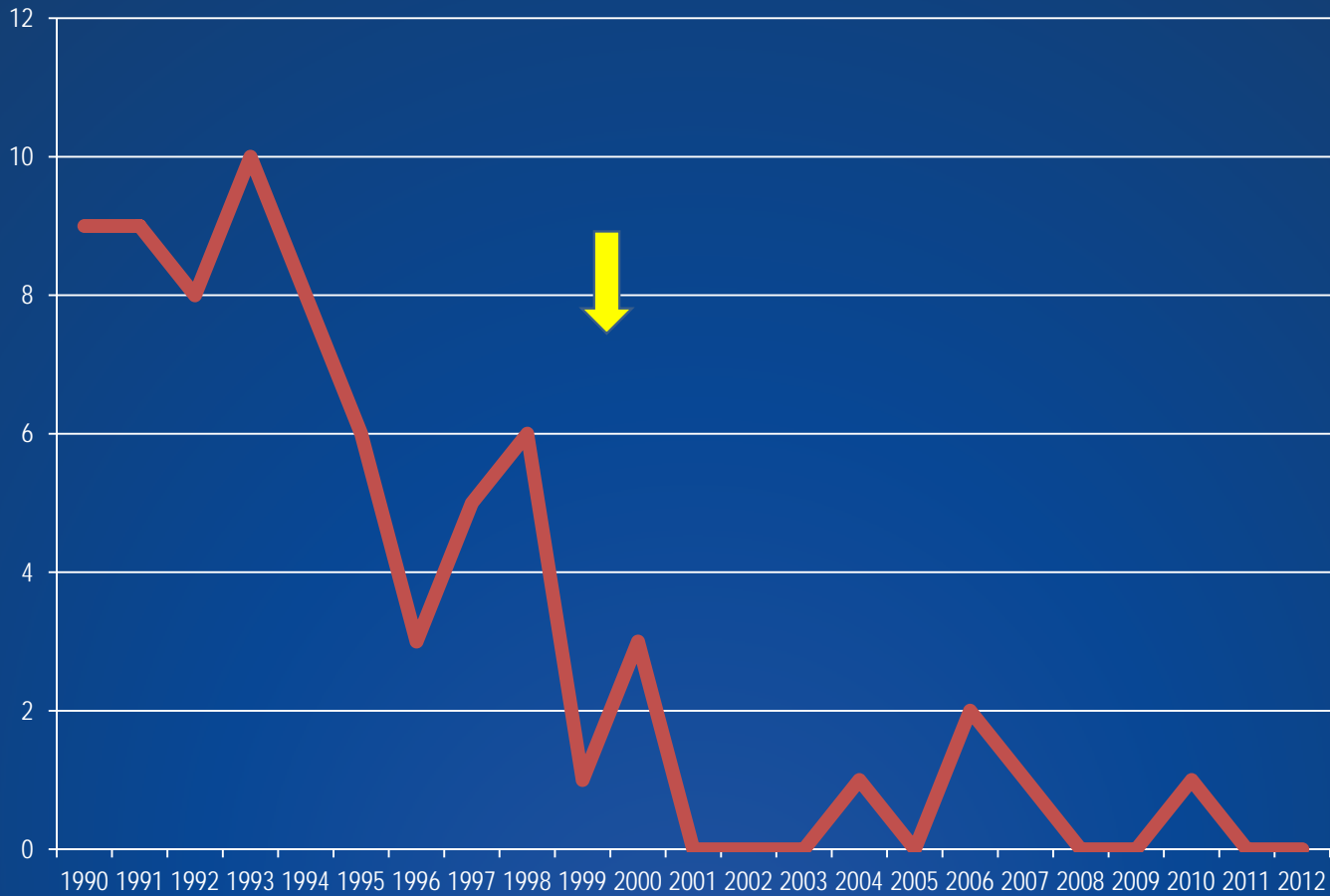
Perinatal HIV transmission in Mississippi



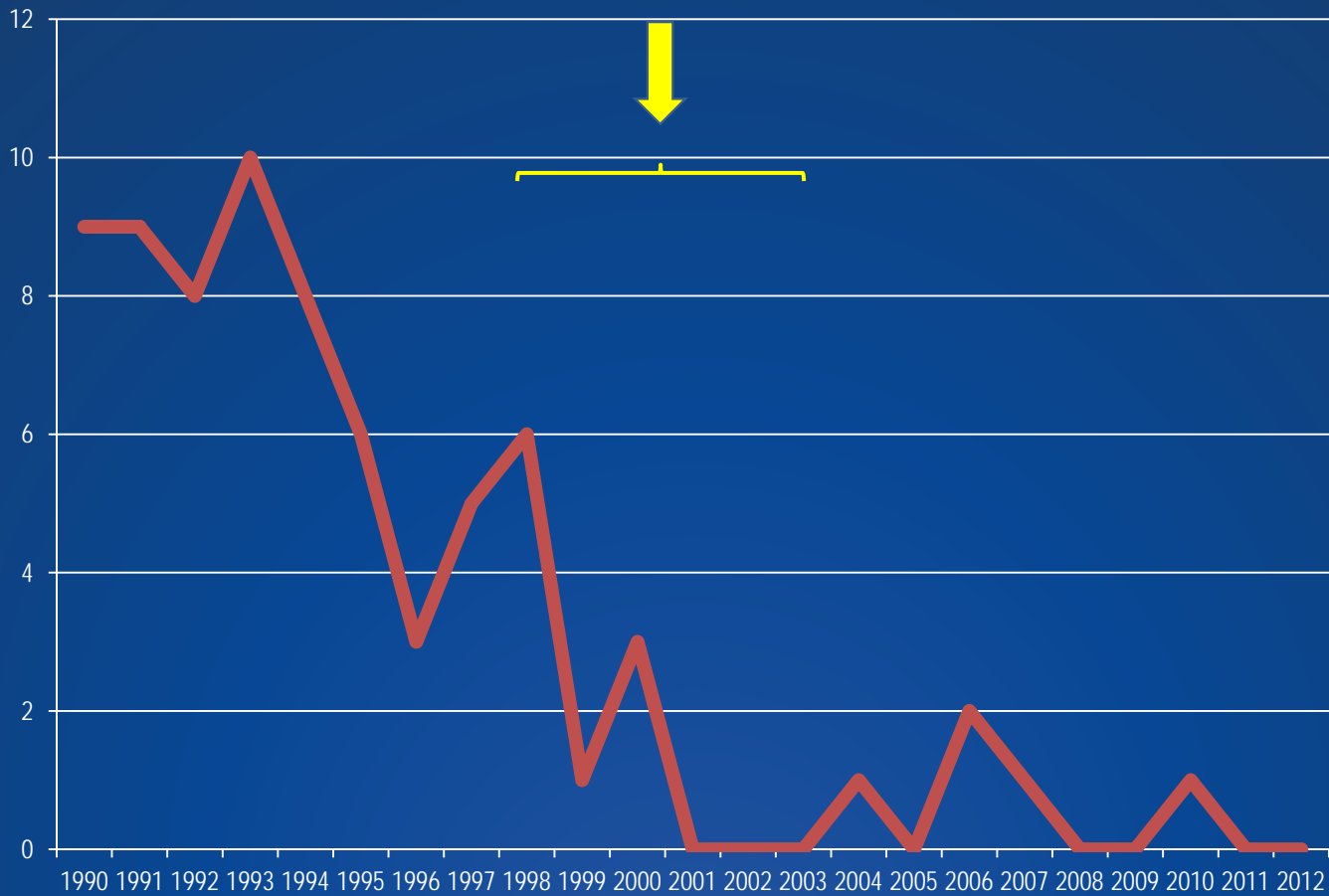




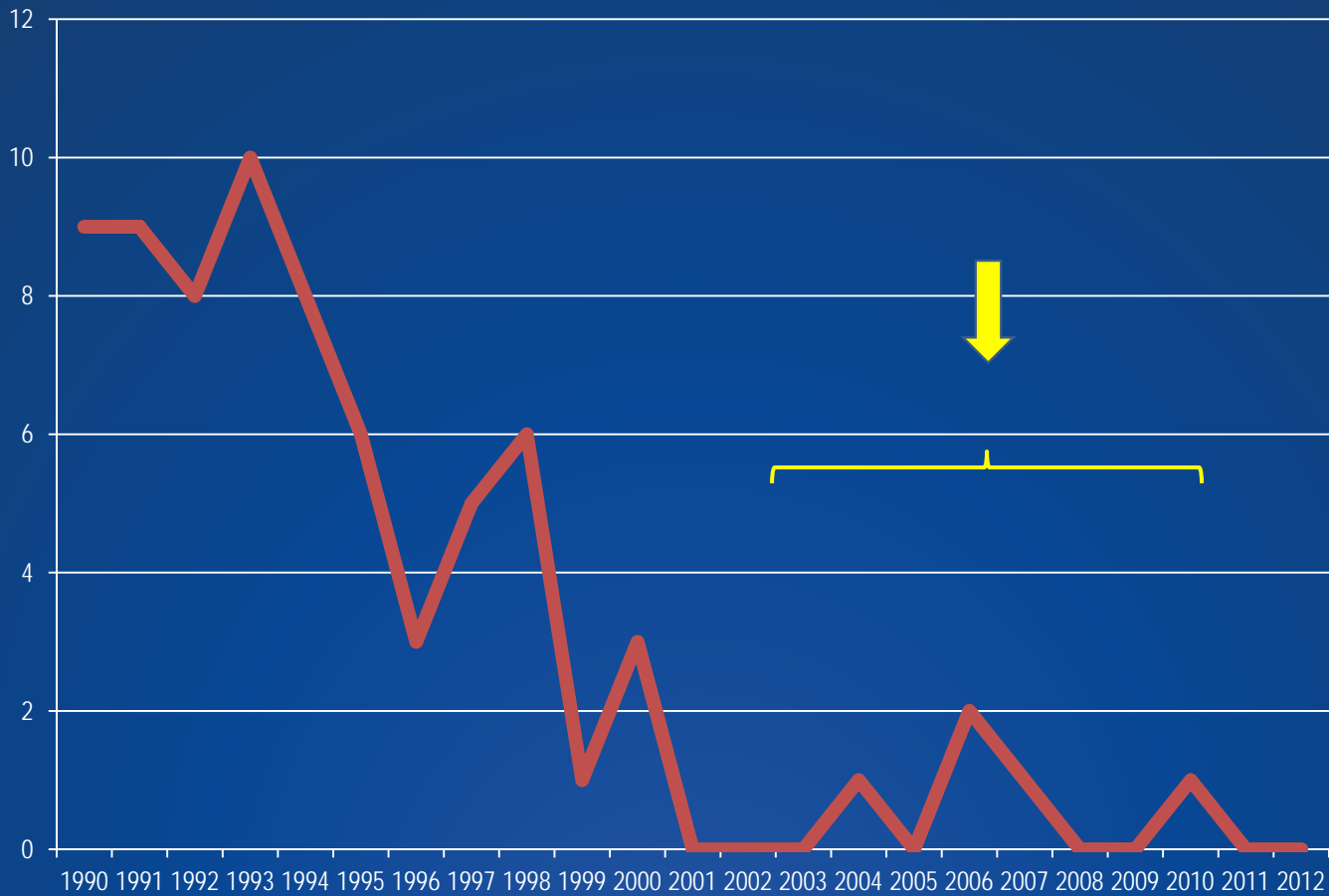
PACTG protocol 076 results – the beginning of transmission prevention
